Specifics for the peggy squares are:

- 100% wool or wool blend – please note which you are using.
- Double knit yarn and use 4mm needles or crochet hook.
- Any colour you like.
- Cast on 35 stitches, knit 61 rows then cast off.




Hymns printed on Sundays order of service:
