Knit and Knatter Group

We will be meeting at the church on Thursday, 11am for coffee, knitting and knattering. Anyone is welcome, you don't even need to do knitting. We will be making peggy squares into blankets. If you would like to knit but are unable to join us, we would welcome your contribution. If you have wool that you would like to donate, please talk with Nicola.

Specifics for the peggy squares are:

- 100% wool or wool blend please note which you are using.
- Double knit yarn and use 4mm needles or crochet hook.
- Any colour you like.
- Cast on 35 stitches, knit 61 rows then cast off.
