The Fijian congregation are at Napier this weekend for their district meeting and to support one of the newest Fijian congregations and celebrate Fathers Day with them.

The Wellington Methodist Endowment Trust is looking for a new secretary. Could you be that person? The Trust helps maintain, educate, support, and develop children and young people, of Māori or of other cultures in Aotearoa New Zealand. This is achieved through the annual allocation of grants to schools (and school-related organisations) in the greater Wellington region, to support projects that are focused on the personal development of children and young people. The Trust looks particularly for projects that are innovative and creative and help address inequality.

The Trust is seeking a secretary to manage the its administrative affairs. The position requires about 10-12 hours monthly with significant time commitments preparing for the two meetings per year and coordinating the school applications. The position is provided with an honorarium (based on \$40 per hour for 250 hours per annum).
