I remember my first meeting with George where we shared a lot of stories, and stories of people we knew in common. I had been impressed with his knowledge and ability to keep up to date with what was happening in the world and in our church. He was always keen to know what was going on and to engage in conversation about how to make the world a better place. Despite a desire to be able to continue to attend worship at Wesley, his physical limitations meant he couldn't participate in person - however he was a regular viewer of our worship on-line.
